ENTRY FEE: \$125 - Bring check with you if not already paid if possible.

FORMAT:

- 2 pools of four teams
- both courts play simultaneously
- each game will start at 4 points
- Round robin pool play- 2 of 3 games to 25 with a cap at 27 (3rd game to 15, cap 17) in each pool. Overall record of wins and losses will determine seeding for placement play. The tie-breaker procedure will be as follows: Head to head competition and then point differential if necessary; for three way ties, fewest number of defensive points allowed in pool play. Top two teams in each pool will play in the championship rounds.
- Championship round 1 -- crossover / best 2 of 3 (25 pt games/15 pt third game)
- Championship final -- championship (large gym) 2 of 3 (25 pt. Games – Start at 4 – 3rd game if necessary to 15 – start at 0.
- Third Place (Small Gym) 2 of 3 (25 pt. Games – Start at 4 – 3rd game if necessary to 15 – start at 0.
